## **About Atlantic Edge Credit Union Scholarship Program**

The Atlantic Edge Credit Union Scholarship program recognizes the contribution of our community builders of tomorrow. There are five scholarship awards each valued at \$500, and the application deadline is October 15, 2022.

## Details and Eligibility

Five scholarships of \$500 each will be awarded to students who are entering their first year of studies at a post-secondary institution.

These scholarships are available to students who are residents in the following regions served by Atlantic Edge Credit Union Limited.

- One scholarship valued at \$500 will be awarded in the region from L'Anse au Clair to Red Bay.
- One scholarship valued at \$500 will be awarded in the region from Lodge Bay to Cartwright.
- One scholarship valued at \$500 will be awarded in the region from Goose Cove to Rocky Harbour.
- One scholarship valued at \$500 will be awarded in the region from Lake Melville – North.
- One scholarship valued at \$500 will be awarded in the region of Deer Lake/Hampden/Pollards Point.

Successful applicant must be:

- Under 20 years of age.
- Entering their first year of post-secondary schooling in the year of application.
- Enrolled or enrolling in a minimum of two-year program.
- Either applicant, or applicant's parent(s) or guardian(s), must be a member of Atlantic Edge Credit Union.

The award will be made to those students who, during their high school program have demonstrated:

- Academic ability, industry, and promise.
- Achieved a high academic grade in seven Level III courses which are subject to final grades.
- In addition to other criteria, if all else is equal, financial need may be taken into consideration in determining an award.

Applications must be completed by the student and returned to Atlantic Edge Credit Union **on or before October 15, 2022.**

Successful applicants will be notified on or before November 30, 2022.
